

Notice of the King's Lynn Triathlon Clubs Annual General Meeting

The election of officers will normally be by a show of hands.

The AGM will also consider a range of important club matters as determined by the Chairman. In addition, if you have any other business that you feel is relevant to the AGM, then please note that this should be submitted to the secretary, in writing, at least seven days before the meeting. This year's open forum, which takes place after the official AGM, will centre around the introduction of a junior section to the club.
